Extended Information on the Use of Cookies

Use of Cookies

The website www.ivet-learntolearn.eu, managed by the Istituto Superiore Internazionale Salesiano di Ricerca Educativa - ISRE, located in via dei Salesiani, n. 15 in Mestre Venice, in the person of its legal representative pro tempore, uses cookies to make the navigation services offered through it simple and efficient for users who view the pages.

The user who views our website will see inserted in the navigation software (browser) of the device used, whether it is a computer or another mobile device, minimal amounts of information contained in small text files called "cookies". Cookies are saved in the folders of the hard disk, or non-volatile memory of the device, used by the browser itself for its operation.

Various types of cookies are used, some of which¹ serve to make the use of the website more effective, while others to enable certain functionalities.

Analyzing them in a more detailed way, we see that cookies allow:

- to store the preferences entered by the user;
- to avoid re-entering the same information several times during the visit, such as username and password if requested;
- to analyze the use of services and content provided by the website to optimize the browsing experience and services offered.

With a function partially analogous to this last type of cookie, passive user data detection systems called fingerprints can be used, which communicate to the site manager the type of operating system and browser used, the size of the windows on the screen, their video resolution,² etc.

Types of Cookies Used on the Website www.ivet-learntolearn.eu

The types of cookies used by the website www.ivet-learntolearn.eu are:

– Technical Cookies

This type of cookie allows the correct functioning of some sections of the website. They can be of two categories, persistent and session:

- **persistent:** once the browser is closed, they are not³ destroyed but keep track of⁴ the navigation until a preset expiration date;
- **session:** they are deleted every time the browser is closed.

These cookies, always sent from the domain of the navigation site, are⁵ necessary to view the site correctly and in relation to the technical services⁶ offered, will therefore always be used and sent, unless the user changes the settings in their browser (potentially affecting, in this way, the display⁷ of the site pages).

– Analytical Cookies

Cookies in this category are used to collect information on the use⁸ of the site. We will use this information regarding anonymous statistical analysis to improve the use of the site and to make⁹ the content more interesting and relevant to the wishes of the users. This type of cookie collects data anonymously¹⁰ on the activity of the users and how they arrived on the site. Analytical cookies are sent from the site itself or from third-party¹¹ domains. Among them are the cookies generated by the Google Analytics (universal) service.

– Third-Party Analytical Cookies

Specification of the previous ones, these cookies are used to collect information on the use of the site by users in anonymous form such as: pages visited, time spent,¹² origins of traffic, geographical origin, age, gender and interests for the purposes of marketing campaigns. These cookies are sent from third-party¹³ domains external to our sites. Among them are the cookies of Google Analytics with anonymized IP and conversion tracking of Google Ads.

According to art. 122 of the Privacy Code and the guidelines of the Italian Privacy Authority of 10.06.2021, ISRE is not required to ask for consent for technical and analytical cookies placed on its site, as they are used for the sole purpose of transmitting an electronic communication over a telecommunications network and to the extent strictly¹⁴ necessary to the provider of a specific service, explicitly requested by the contractor or user, to provide that service.

For all other types of cookies, consent may instead be expressed by the user in one or more of the following ways:

- Through specific configurations of the browser used or the related computer programs used to navigate the¹⁵ pages that make up the website.
- By changing the settings in the use of third-party services.

Both¹⁶ of these solutions could prevent the user from using or viewing¹⁷ parts of the www.ivet-learntolearn.eu website.
